## Alcatel Omni PCX PABX User Key setup.

This instruction is applicable for setup of User keys on the following Alcatel Handsets.

Alcatel 4039, 4029, 4038IP 4028IP 8029, 8039 and 8028IP & 8038IP

The model number can be found on the label on the underneath of the phone.

To program a soft key on your handset push the button followed by the button you want to program. The onscreen menu will then allow entry of a Name and Number.

The number can be either internal or external, note that external numbers must include the 0 prefix to access an outside line.

Buttons are nested and lower levels can be accessed by using the up/down scroll keys on the keypad.

**NOTE:** Any pre-programmed buttons for Line positions, Call Keys, Night Switch, etc are not editable and must be programmed using the PCX software tool.

Some pre-programmed buttons may be editable, e.g. diversion buttons can have the target number changed.

**IMPORTANT:** It is not possible to effectively use the PCX programming tool without proper training, to do so without training can result in corruption of the system database requiring a complete reload of the database by TCS.

If you require the PCX tool and instruction TCS can install the programming software and provide tuition at our normal hourly rates.
